**Place: Winter Harbor, Maine**

The Northeastern Forest Health Field Workshop will be held on June 2-5 at the Schoodic Educational and Research Center ([SERC](#), picture on right), Winter Harbor, Maine. Check-in will begin Tuesday evening, June 2, and 7:30 am on June 3. The theme for **Wednesday's field trip is "Using Silviculture to Reduce Risk from Pests" and will begin at SERC.** It will focus on spruce/fir, American beech, and eastern white pine forest types. **Thursday's field trips will examine the "Forest Health of Acadia National Park" and will begin at the ANP Visitor Center** parking lot by 9 am on Mount Desert Island. It will focus on invasive species, air pollution, and monitoring. There will also be time available in the evenings and Friday for activity reports from the attendees.



## Registration Costs

- **Regular:** Each field trip is \$50 or \$100 for both.
- **Maine SAF Members:** The cost is \$35 per field trip or \$70 for both.
- Price includes transportation, lunch, and snacks.

## Lodging
