

# **Fishing for Answers Downeast Solutions for Fish Passage**

Join us for a tour of fish passage management in the Downeast Region of Maine. The first half of the day will be spent on land managed by Wagner Forest Management in Township's 27 and 21. There will be two examples of crossings repaired to improve fish passage. The speaker's will be Keith Kanoti of the Maine Forest Service, Scott Craig of the U.S Fish and Wildlife Service, and Travis Howard of Wagner Forest Management. They will discuss the history of the sites as well as opportunities that exist for applying for grants for fish passage projects.

The second half of the day will be spent on the Downeast Lakes Land Trust as well as GLS Timberlands LLC. We will view an arch culvert installation on the Land Trust and talk about the Land Trust's efforts to improve fish passage on their management. The final stop will be to view a new bridge installation on a brook trout stream in Grand Lake Stream Township as well as a harvest done on the same stream's buffer.
