Please join us as we travel to the communities of Piscataquis County to tour three exemplary forestry and wood processing sites.

We will start at Pleasant River Lumber, which is Maine’s only family-owned spruce dimensional lumber mill in Maine. With recent upgrades, they produce 85 million board feet a year.

Next, we will travel to the Piscataquis County Soil & Water Conservation District (PCSWCD) Demonstration Forest. Once owned by the White Mountain National Forest, this forest showcases a rich history and diverse forestry practices.

There will also be an opportunity to learn about the Maine Forest Service’s initiative to increase active management of small woodlots in Central and Southern Maine.

Finally, we will travel to a paired-parcel small woodlot. Through the stewardship of a model landowner, these two parcels show the work of good forest management and challenges of rehabilitation.
