Tour participants will get a close-up view of the barge used for transporting trucks and harvesting equipment to and from Deer Island. The barge landing sites will be reviewed and permitting and construction issues explained. Active trucking and barge transportation will be observed as well.

We will be visiting the logging sites and discussing the applied silvicultural systems.
